

JETSETV F.C. (COVID-19) Response Plan

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, JETSETV F.C. is proposing the following guidelines to ensure the safety and health of our coaches, volunteers, parents and players.

These changes are aligned with the Center for Disease Control (CDC), National Institute of Health (NIH) and World Health Organization (WHO) guidelines and are subject to change as the pandemic and local restrictions are updated.

As government and local jurisdictional policies are updated, we will be in communication with the players and families to ensure they are up to date on any changes.

Please be aware that this is not a substitute or replacement of any guidelines that have been issued by the CDC, NIH, WHO, or government requirements.

During Phase 1:

We recommend that families follow CDC recommendations at home.

NO FULL CONTACT SOCCER WILL BE ALLOWED UNTIL PALM BEACH COUNTY PHASE 3 REOPENING

Field Regulations:

- Clean uniform must be worn always.
- Clean sneakers or cleats must be worn.
- Soccer balls must be cleaned before the start of practice.
- Players will be dropped off directly with club staff.
- Temperature digital reader checks will be taken before you enter the fields (upon parental signed waiver).
- Hands must be sanitized before and after practice and games at the sanitation station.
- Dirty hands need to be washed with soap and water or an approved hand sanitizer (contains at least 60% alcohol).
- No gathering of people will be permitted.
- No player(s) will be allowed to attend if he/she has any flu-like symptoms or has been in close contact with someone who has experienced flu-like symptoms.
- No hand shaking or elbow bumping
- No close contact – must maintain at least six feet from each other.
- No one is allowed to roam freely at practice
- No spitting or clearing of the mouth.
- Water bottles must be marked clearly and placed in designated location.
- Players will work in grids at least 6 feet apart unless they are part of the same family social distancing together.
- Only skill learning activities will be practiced during stage 1.
- Ratio to coaches or volunteers will be smaller (4-6).
- No exchanging of snacks or drinks.
- When on Park Ave. field, no restroom will be available for use. When on 7th St. field, the following restroom protocol will be put in place.

- Always wash hands after going to the restroom.
- Restroom to be disinfected after every use by JETSETV F.C. staff.
- Face cover is recommended for players but not mandatory.

Parent/Guardian:

- No parent or guardian will be allowed inside the field.
- Parents and guardian are asked to follow social distancing rules while waiting for the players outside the field.
- Maintain social distancing while sending players on and off the field.
- Parents encouraged that all player equipment and water bottles are cleaned before and after leaving the fields.
- No Clearing of the mouth at the fields.
- Maintain social distancing from any other observers (6' apart) from anyone not in your household.
- Face cover is recommended for parents and guardians.

Coaches/ Trainers:

- Temperature checked before start of practice.
- Coaches are required to wear a face mask.
- Ensure equipment is cleaned before and after each session.
- Develop a training plan in accordance with the club, county and CDC guidelines on safety and social distancing. Make zonal areas where appropriate, coaching smaller groups of 4-6 players.
- No close contact with players or parents - CDC guidelines.
- No spitting or clearing of the mouth.
- No providing of snacks or drinks to any players.
- When moving the goals sanitize or wash hands after with CDC guidelines.
- All benches to be washed before and after soccer day usage.

During Phase 2:

We recommend that families follow CDC recommendations at home.
